How?		All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. How does PC Credit Inc. protect my personal information?	<p>To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.</p> <p>We also limit access to your information to employees with a need-to-know to perform their job functions.</p>
How does PC Credit Inc. collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">open an account or pay your billsapply for a loan or give us your income informationprovide employment information <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.</p>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthinessaffiliates from using your information to market to yousharing for non-affiliates to market to you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	<p>Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.</p>
Definitions	
Affiliates	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><i>Our affiliates include financial companies in Louisiana such as Purvis Credit Inc., Metro Credit Co., Audubon Credit Inc., and PC Credit Inc., (New Iberia and Houma locations)</i>
Non-affiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><i>PC Credit Inc. does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you.</i>
Joint marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><i>PC Credit Inc. doesn't jointly market.</i>
